Kubbs (rhymes with tubes), is an easy to learn, lawn game that is hugely popular in Scandinavia where it is sometimes known as 'Viking Chess'. It is just beginning to catch on in Australia. It is an ideal Team Building activity as it is accessible to all ability levels; it's fun and builds connectedness.

Essentially, teams try to knock down wooden blocks by throwing wooden batons at them, but some simple and clever rules mean that teams require strategy, as much as accurate throwing to win. It is suitable for teams of up to six players a side. Playing Kubbs has an element of competitiveness, but it is highly inclusive and encourages plenty of fun banter. It is an ideal activity after a Treasure Hunt to bring everyone back together. Multiple Kubbs sets are available, so a finals/play off system could easily be included.
